Note: Two evaluation systems run side by side at Vilnius University since September 1, 1993: ten-point system and pass/fail system. Examinations and work defence evaluations are graded, 5 and higher being a passing grade and 4 and lower - a failing grade. The courses that do not end with examinations use the pass/fail system to test if a student has earned the credits allocated to it. A student passes when he/she proves that he/she assimilated not less than 50% of required knowledge scope.

The academic year consists of two semesters and a student has to earn 40 credits, 20 credits during each.

Semester - 16 study weeks plus four weeks of session period.

Credit unit: VU credit is one study week and requires the input of approximately 40 hours of student work. One VU credit = 1,5 ECTS.

A total of 160 credits is required for Bachelor degree (4 years of studies).

A total of 80 credits is required for Master degree (2 years of studies).
